

# **EXISTING ROPES**

Last updated Oct 2020

### Front EIGHT bells plus the SEMITONES should be Specification No.1

Tail 11'6" = 3.5m, 10.5mm diameter, hemp or flax, 3' sally, 47' top end.

The semitones have pale blue, blue and white sallies

### **OLD/SPARE ROPES**

Old ropes are hung on two rails in the carillon room, the inner one being ropes kept for cathedral use and the outer rail holding those available for use in other towers. The outer rail has mostly terylene-topped ropes but as they come mostly from the back bells they are not much use anywhere else. However, new tails or even new sallies could be spliced on to them.

We now have **eight old ropes with dyneema tops.** The plan is to keep re-using these – rope manufacturers will create a new sally and tail and splice it on for half the cost of a complete new rope (the top does get shortened slightly in the process), but they won't splice on a sally and tail from elsewhere. The first two to be used this way went to Ellis Oct 2019 and came back Mar 2020. The plan is to refurbish two every year.

Two are currently with Avon Ropes (Oct 2020), planned to be put on treble and 9th.

At any one time there will usually be 2 with a rope supplier and 6 in the tower -
